Cornelia wurde um 1930 in Nachbarschaft des heutigen Bootsanlegers in Pirlangimpi geboren. Als junge Frau half sie jungen Flechtern, ihr Wissen und Geschick in dieser Kunstform zu entwickeln. Sie brachte auch jungen Leuten traditionellen Tiwi-Tanz bei. Sie heiratete Steven Tipuamantumirri als junge Frau und hat eine Tochter, Delores Tipuamantumirri. Sie half außerdem, einen Jungen aus Peppimenarti, Harry Wilson, großzuziehen, der aus der Stolen Generation stammte, nach Pirlangimpi geschickt worden war und später die bekannte Künstlerin Regina Wilson aus Peppimenarti heiratete.

Cornelia Tipuamantumirri verwendet die kayimwagakimi-Technik für ihre Arbeit, indem sie ein kammförmiges Stück geschnitztes Eisenholz in ihre Ockerfarben tunkt; sie verwendet gern Schattierungen aus Rosa und Gelb, um ihr langes Leben auf den Tiwi Islands widerzuspiegeln. Sie zeigt auch die Reflektionen des Lichts auf der Oberfläche der Arafurasee.
